

WAYUMI QUEST FAQ

- 1. **Why Wayumi Quest?** What better way to expose your students to an introduction to missions and have a blast doing it?
- 2. **Will we be eating grub worms?** Only one, JK. No, we serve great food in the dining hall, no grubs or bugs are on the menu.
- 3. Where do we sleep? In lodging rooms in twin bunk beds.
- 4. How many participants can you house? We can easily house up to 80 people.
- 5. **Who can attend?** High School youth groups (7-12th grade) accompanied by youth leaders/chaperones
- 6. **Can a High School student come alone?** No, the program is intended for groups, including adult leaders/chaperones.
- 7. **Is there a minimum number of participants?** Yes. There needs to be 25+ participants to book a Wayumi Quest.
- 8. Where is Wayumi? Central PA (241 Old Forge Hill Road, Jersey Shore, PA 17740)
- 9. How long is Wayumi Quest? From Friday supper through Sunday lunch.
- 10. What happens at Wayumi Quest? Awesome stuff! You'll have to come find out.
- 11. How is Wayumi Quest different from other camps? No other retreat center focuses on missions like we do.
- 12. **What does the cost include?** Meals, snacks, lodging, and all necessary expenses. You may want to bring extra money for the Gift Shop.
- 13. What can I purchase at the Gift Shop? Wayumi clothing and souvenirs, books on global missions, flashlights, jewelry & other fun stuff.
- 14. What are the leaders/chaperones responsible for? They need to sleep in lodging with the students but are not responsible for any of the program activities. They get the opportunity to experience Wayumi with their students.
- 15. What should I bring? Sleeping bag, Bible, sneakers, towel, etc...you know...regular retreat stuff.
